Geography - North America

Writing:

Reading:

We will continue to develop our test techniques and skills in preparation for SATS.

Maths:

We will be working on revisiting elements on co-ordinates and geometry. Calculation using the 4 operations and fractions.

Our Morning Maths work recaps lots of work we have already done to make sure we don't forget this knowledge.

Homework:

Each week your child will bring home spellings to practise as well as Maths homework. They may also have additional curriculum work or Reading to complete about their topic.

Wider curriculum:

Music: We will continue exploring music around the unit theme of jazz!

French: We will be developing our language around French words that describe our homes.
